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THE SERMON IN ONE BREATH

Loving God was designed to travel from one generation to the next. Four movements: three generations deep (6:1-3), all your much (6:4-5), a thousand small conversations (6:6-7), and what does your house say (6:8-9). The sermon's illustrations: a relay handoff in the exchange zone, the Hebrew words behind heart, soul, and strength, the mezuzah on a Jewish doorframe, and five caring adults around every child.

WHERE THE OBSERVATION QUESTIONS ARE HEADING

- **Question 6, verses 1-3.** You, your son, and your grandson. Three generations, named before the word love ever appears.
- **Question 8, verses 4-5.** Heart, the control center; soul, the whole breathing self; and strength, which simply means much. Everything that fills our hands.
- **Question 10, verses 6-7.** In your heart first, then repeated to children in four moments: sitting at home, walking on the road, lying down, and getting up.
- **Question 13, verses 8-9.** On the hand, the forehead, the doorposts, and the city gates. Every one is a place you pass through or look at every single day.

ONE FACILITATION TIP

Two of the questions in this guide ask people to name a young person within their reach. Have the names of a few kids and students from LOFT ready before the meeting, so nobody stalls on not knowing anyone. The point is not only to name someone but to leave with a first step.
